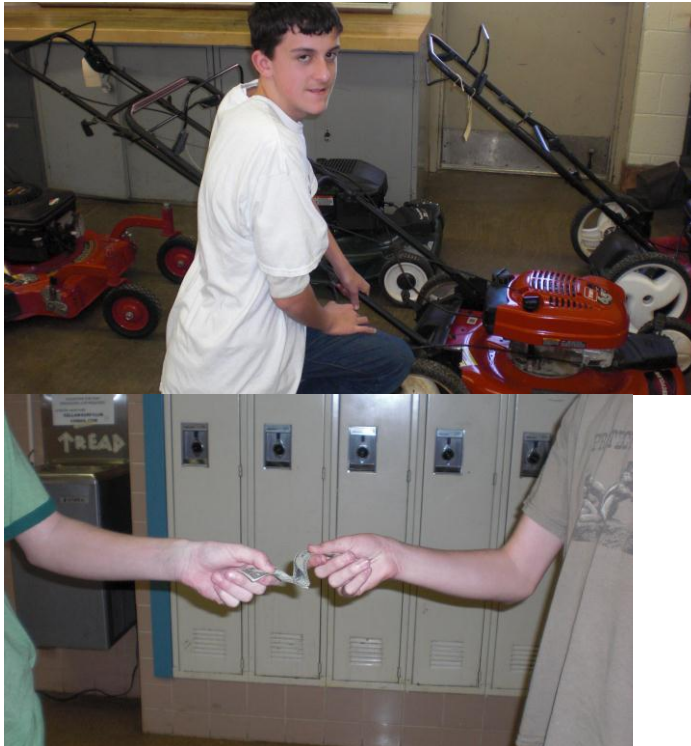




Time of Need?
